**Advanced Group Counselling: Integrating

Presenter

Dr. Marv Westwood, Professor, Counselling Psychology, UBC; Associate Member, Faculty of Medicine UBC; Registered Psychologist (Limited Register). Dr. Westwood's teaching and research areas focus on group counselling and psychotherapy, trauma repair and therapeutic use of the guided autobiographical life review method to the counselling process. His most recent work includes development and evaluation of a group based approach to trauma repair – therapeutic enactment. He has developed several personal development programs for professionals using Guided Autobiography and therapeutic enactment methods.

- Learn how action based methods of therapeutic enactment facilitate client awareness, emotional expression, and promote client change processes.
- Understand the planning and leading competencies required by the group leader and how to assess client readiness for this type of group therapeutic method.
- Opportunity to experience and observe the 9 different process levels of this method from the perspective of client and group leader.
- Develop a working model for how to integrate aspects of this model into your current level of group training, and learn how to assess appropriateness for inclusion.
